- **Best interests decision** means what you plan for me will be best for me



- **Cremated** means when your body is burned after you have died



- **Culture** means the things that are important to you because of where you were brought up, what you have experienced or what your background is



- **Donating my organs** means letting someone else have your organs after you have died



- **Formal** means serious and when things are done in the way they are usually done for everyone



- **Head stone** is a stone that goes on the ground to say where you have been buried or where your ashes are if you have been **cremated**



- **Hospice** means somewhere you can go to be looked after when you are at the end of your life



- **Informal** means relaxed and done in a way that is different from the way things are usually done



- **Lasting power of attorney** means you have told a solicitor you want someone else to speak for you and make decisions for you if are not able to



- **Mental capacity** means being able to make a decision that needs to be made



- **Religious leader** means someone from your religion who knows you and gives you help, guidance and support



- **Remembrance book** is a book where people can write down their memories of you



- **Spiritually** means your religion or the things you believe in
